The Livonia Police Department will allow residents to dispose their unused medications on a quarterly basis.

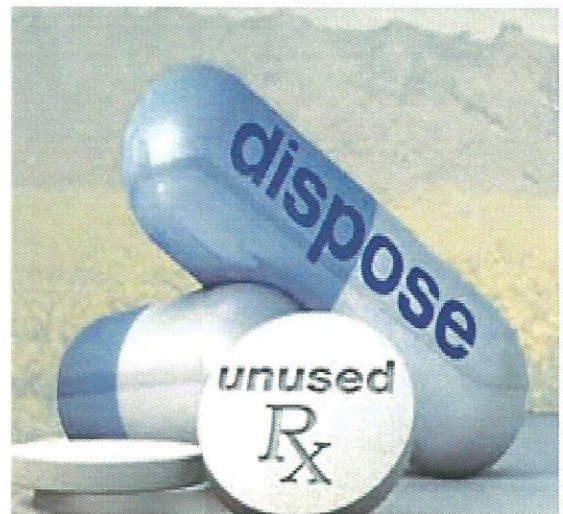
Drop-off Schedule

Saturday/Sunday of the second weekend of March, June, September, December

2018 Dates: March 10/11, June 9/10, September 8/9, December 8/9

Guidelines:

- **Livonia residents only, identification required at the time of disposal**
- **Pills only; no needles, liquids, powder, ointments, or inhalers**
- **Place pills in a closed Ziploc bag**
- **Black out the name on prescription container and dispose in your home**
- **No over-the-counter-medications**
